ENVIRONMENT

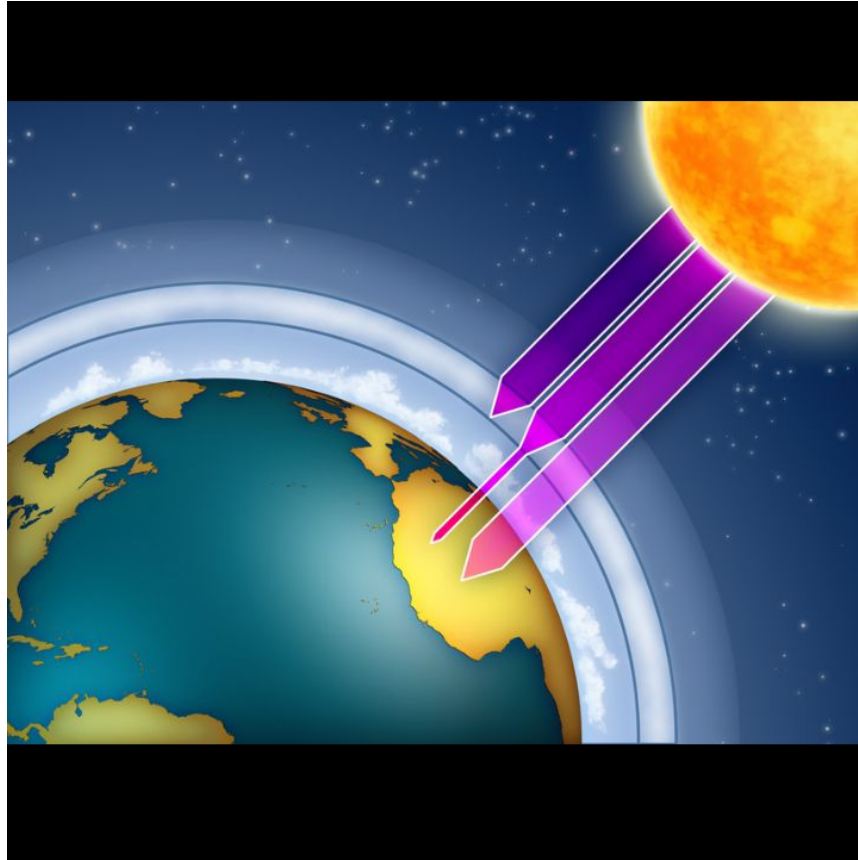
- the natural world, as a whole or in a particular geographical area, especially as affected by human activity

OZONE LAYER

The ozone layer is a layer with a high concentration of ozone in the stratosphere (above the earth's surface) and protects us from ultraviolet radiation.

ACID RAIN

- Rainfall made so acidic by atmospheric pollution that it causes environmental harm, chiefly to forests and lakes. The main cause is the industrial burning of coal and other fossil fuels, the waste gases from which contain sulphur and nitrogen oxides which combine with atmospheric water to form acids.

3R's

- 3Rs refers to three terms often used when talking about waste: Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. Reducing is cutting back on the amount of trash we make, reusing is finding a new way to use trash so that we don't have to throw it out, and recycling is using trash to remake new goods that can be sold again.

REUSE

- To reuse something is to make use of it more than once, or for a subsequent time.

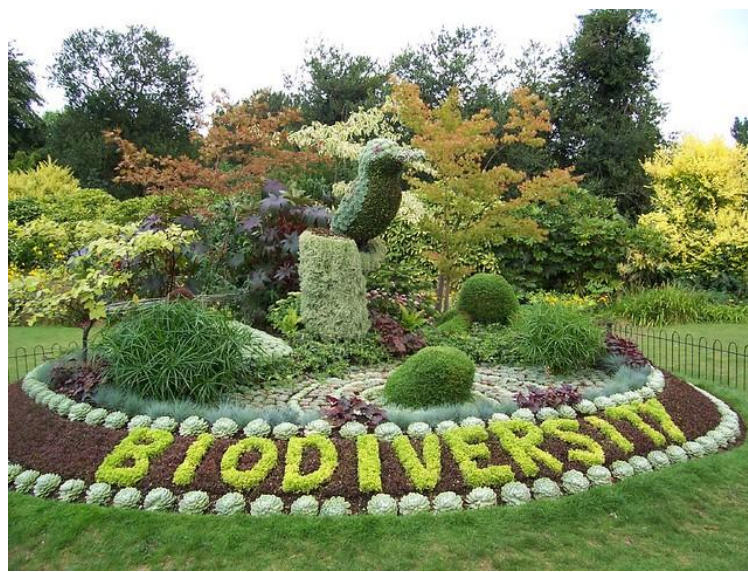
DROUGHT

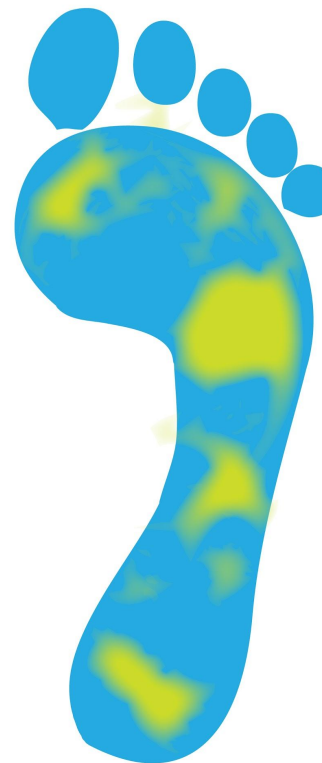


CARBON FOOTPRINT

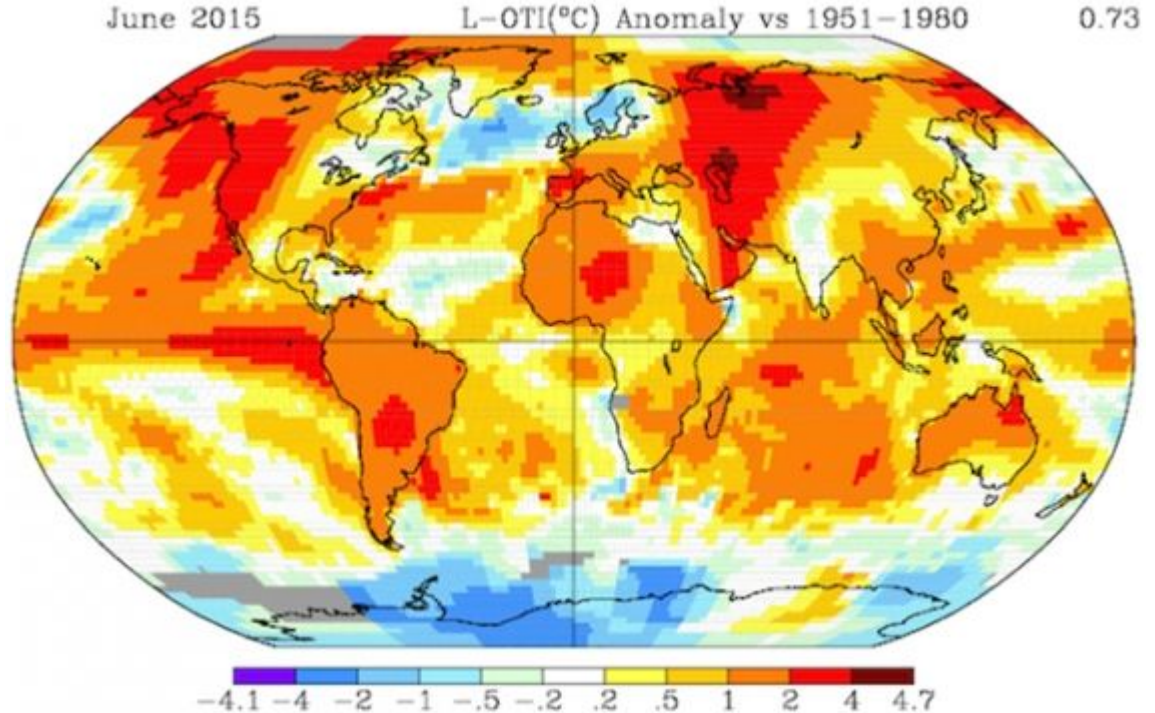
- A group of living organisms consisting of similar individuals capable of gene exchange or crossing.

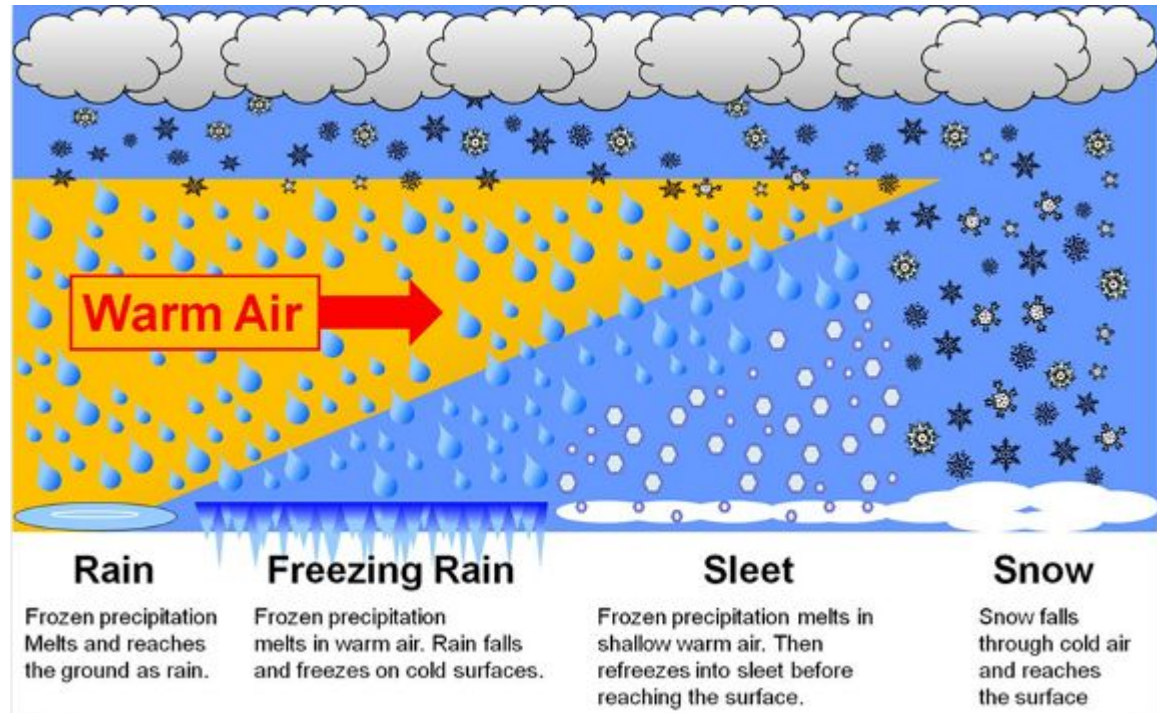
GLOBAL WARMING

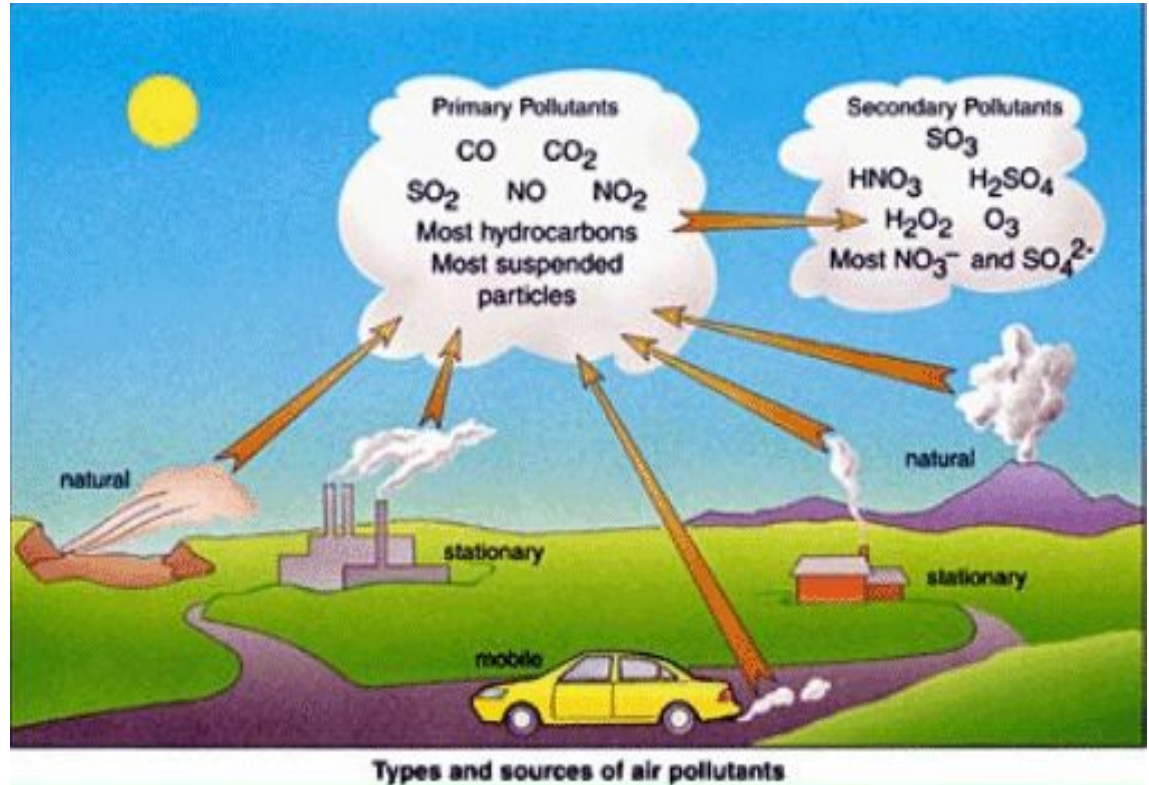

GREAT PACYFIC GARBAGE PATCH

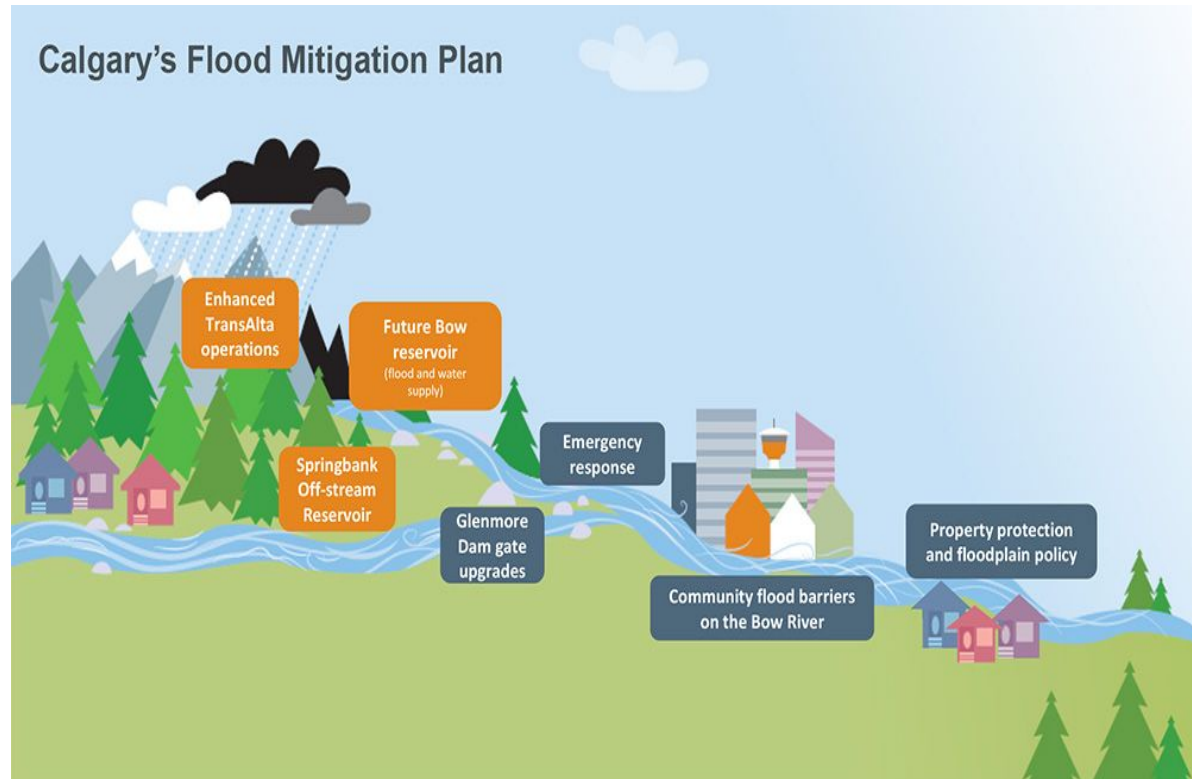
- This is the world's largest floating garbage dump in the Pacific. This drifting island of garbage is twice the size of France.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

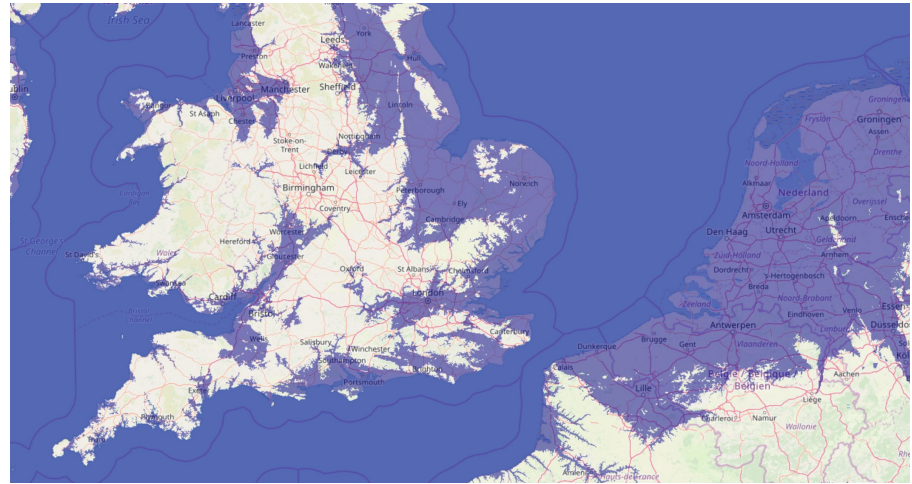
- **Environmental protection** is the practice of **protecting** the natural **environment** by individuals, organisations and governments.
